# HIHO CA CLUB Program Guidelines



# **Drop Off/Pick Up**

- Drop off and Pick Up will be in our main parking lot.
- When you arrive at camp each day all club members will have their temperatures taken and staff will review a symptom list with parents.
- Please stay in your cars and have your child roll their window down halfway. Please have all individuals in the car wear a mask until the child has been cleared by staff.
- If your child has a temperature of 100 or higher they will be asked to return home. Once the fever has been controlled for over 24 hours without medication, the child is able to return to camp, unless there are additional symptoms.
- Late arrival and early pick up, club members can be dropped off at the office. They will be screened in the office before the parent/guardian leaves.

## **Face Masks**

- We ask that you send a face mask/covering with your child each day.
- Parents/Guardians visiting the office will be required to wear a mask.
- Face masks will be worn at ALL TIMES while at camp.

### **Technology**

• Remember to send your club member with their laptop, iPad, Chromebook, etc. for virtual learning. Please have their name on the item. Camp is WIFI enabled.

# **Daily Programming**

- · Groups will be no more than 10 and spaced out at all times including virtual instruction.
- Please bring a lunch with your child daily.
- Prepare and dress for the weather. We will be outside as much as possible, playing, exploring and having fun.
- We have 172 acres and multiple buildings to utilize for programming to allow for as much social distancing as possible.

# If your Child is Sick or has Covid-19

- If your camper arrives at camp with a fever of 100 degrees or higher or displaying any Covid symptoms they will be asked to return home.
- Once the fever has been controlled for over 24 hours without medication, the camper is able to return to camp, unless there are additional symptoms.
- If a child has any Covid-19 symptoms, they will be required to remain at home until symptoms have subsided. Stay home timeframe could be at least 14 days upon onset of symptoms.
- If your child has been diagnosed with Covid-19, we ask that the child stay home and follow all CDC and your doctors guidelines about when to return to activities.
- If your child has had CLOSE CONTACT with someone infected with Covid-19, we ask that they stay home and quarantine for at least 14 days.
- If a camper becomes ill while at camp, Hiram House will inform all families that there has been a positive case at camp and make necessary recommendations regarding quarantining and/or testing.

# **Cleaning and Disinfecting (Our Commitment To You)**

- Hiram House will be following all CDC and American Camp Association guidelines for cleaning and disinfection.
- Daily activities such as arts n' crafts, archery, etc. will be cleaned after each group.
- Bathrooms and facilities will be cleaned multiple times throughout the day.
- Hand washing will occur throughout the day as needed.
- High touch surfaces will be cleaned multiple times throughout the day.
- All Camp Staff are trained on cleaning and disinfection as well as a general Covid-19 guidelines.
