Our professional camp staff works with you to design programming to support educational goals and objectives. Our programs are available fall, winter, and spring, and are customizable for your needs.

On- or off-site presentations are available for area schools in advance of your visit to assist in preparing your staff, students and parents for their school summer camp experience. Pre-visit tours of camp by school staff or administration are also welcomed when planning your stay at Hiram House Camp.

Group Retreats and Rentals

Group retreats, gatherings, educational programs and seminars of almost any size can be accommodated with or without meal service. One, two or more nights are available during the fall, winter, spring and late summer months. Facilities are available for rent with or without programming. Optional half or full day Teambuilding Adventure Program (high/low ropes, climbing wall) also available.

What We Offer

- Heated log cabins with bunk beds, modern restrooms and shower facilities.
- Each log cabin can comfortably sleep up to 50
- Cabins have a central lounge, sleeping rooms and screened in porch
- Private sleeping quarters for adults and retreat leaders
- Separate staff lodging with showers, restrooms, kitchen and laundry
- Campsites and campfire locations throughout camp
- Treehouse with fireplace
- Nature Center
- Equestrian Center and Farmstead
- Hiking trails, pond, streams and wetlands
- 3,600 square-foot dining hall which comfortably seats 250 people.
- 1890's Fire Station for meeting space or classroom use
- Frontier Fort and Non-denominational outdoor chapel
- On-site parking
- Camp staff on-site for emergencies

Team Building Adventure

Hiram House offers a 16 element High Ropes Course, Low Ropes Adventure Walk and Challenge Elements, two 35 ft Alpine Climbing Walls and various team building activities. Our Teambuilding Adventure Program is the ultimate group challenge. It offers groups and individuals a great opportunity to learn about risk taking, their own perceived limits, how they perform under pressure, how they give and receive support from others and how working collaboratively can help them achieve more than they thought they could accomplish.

The Hiram House teambuilding program is under the supervision of certified specialists. The High Ropes Course was built by Experiential Systems, Inc., an accredited vendor for the Association of Challenge Course Technology (ACCT), and all construction and training adheres to their stringent written standards. Additionally, ESI maintains memberships with the Association for Experiential Education (AEE), The Climbing Wall Association (CWA), The American Camp Association (ACA) and the Outdoor Industry Association (OIA).

Youth must be 10 years of age to participate in the High Ropes Course and 6 years of age for the Climbing Wall. Teambuilding and Adventure Programs are available late summer, fall and spring (weather permitting).
